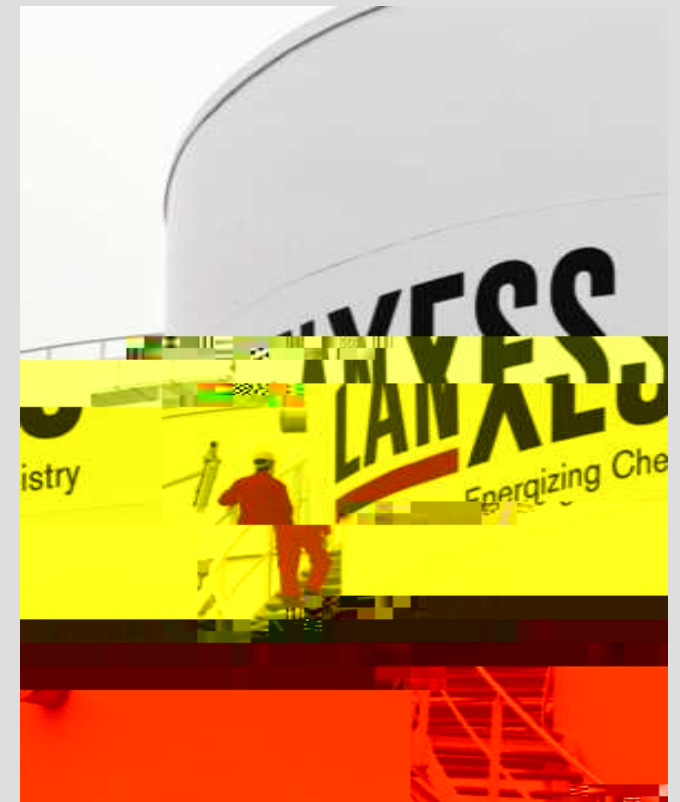

LANXESS – Improvement trend of financials, based on consistent strategy implementation

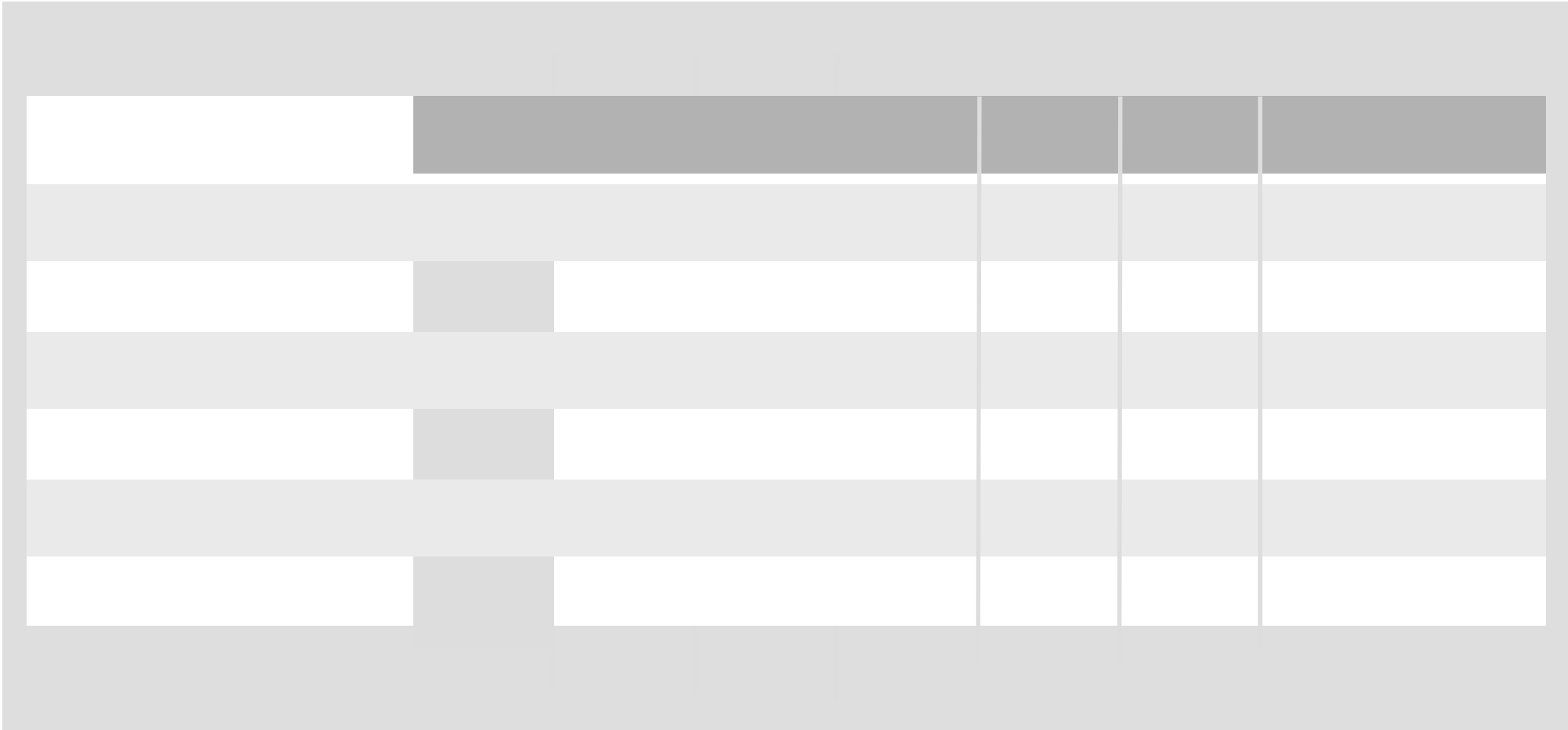

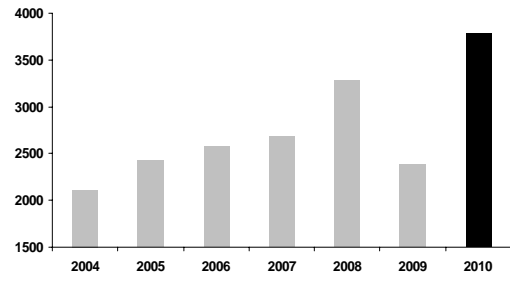

Sales by BU 2010

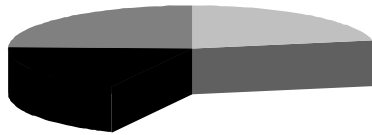

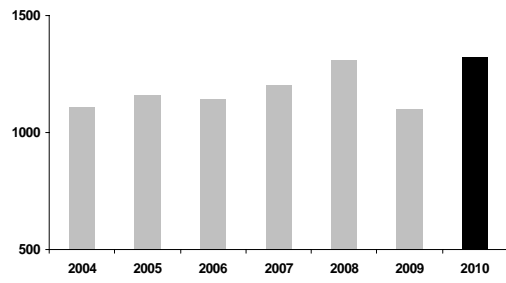

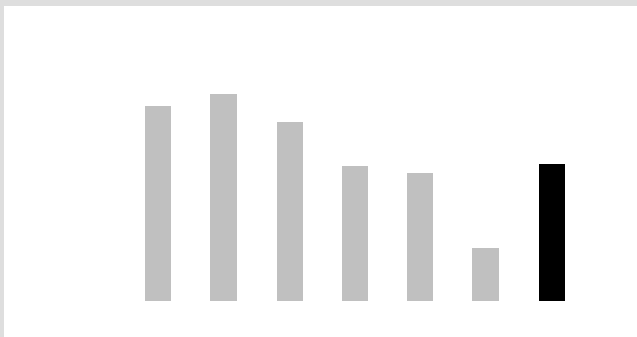
